DIRECTOR'S COMMENTS

I'm excited to bring a classic musical with a modernize twist of Cole Porter's sparkling 1948 musical Kiss Me, Kate. The story is of warring lovers of "The Taming of the Shrew" who are causing trouble both onstage and off. While putting on a musical version of Shakespeare's play, ex-es Fred Graham and Lilli Vanessi can't decide if they're enraged, enamored or enormously confused whenever they cross paths out of character. Throw in some mistaken identity, a pair of surprisingly eloquent gangsters and a whole lot of romantic entanglements, and what you get is Kiss Me, Kate – an updated revival of a dazzling classic that earned the first-ever Tony Award for Best Musical.

Kiss Me, Kate is quite easily one of the two most famous musical "adaptations" of Shakespeare for the stage (the other being West Side Story). Focusing on a theatre company putting up a musical version of "Taming of The Shrew", the musical traces the main relationship between director/leading man Fred Graham and his ex-wife/leading lady Lily Vanessi as they portray the Shakespearen roles of Petruchio and Katherine (the Shrew to be tamed). Kiss Me, Kate was Cole Porter's response to Rodgers and Hammerstein's "Oklahoma!" and other integrated musicals. It was the first show he wrote in which the music and lyrics were connected to the script. It proved to be his biggest hit and the only one of his shows to run for more than 1,000 performances on Broadway. In 1949, the show won the first Tony Award presented for Best Musical. In 2015, the 1949 original cast recording was inducted into the Library of Congress's National Recording Registry.

This razzle-dazzle musical from the Golden Era has proven that it's comedy and social messaging has not aged particularly well so it is our goal to revive this classic into a production that today's audiences will appreciate, respect and enjoy.

Congratulations to the fabulously talented Cast and Crew. I can't thank them enough for their dedication and hard work. And, of course, thank you to Mr. Ott and the entire administration at CGHS for their support.
